With regards the cover under the policy for Boilers, I assume this is in the Pavilion, our policy only provides material damage cover to property caused by an insured peril – i.e. fire, theft, storm, flood etc.

There is no cover for failure or breakdown cover as you would need a specific boiler insurance policy to provide this cover.
